Our site at St. Rose, Belmar is open to any family at no cost. Children from ages 5 -13 participate in level groups currently

serving Level 1 ages 5-6, Level 2 ages 7-8, Level 3 ages 9-10, Level 4 ages 11-13. We now offer a High School level group (ages 14 – 18). Level groups are based on number of participants.

The program offers 12 consecutive meetings, each topic builds on the previous, so there is a requirement of commitment to attending all meetings growing a sense of trust and comfort in the peer group. Our sessions end with a celebration.
